Terminology:

Rāga/dveṣa: Attractions-repulsion. Or likes-dislikes. Or joy-sorrow. Or pleasure-pain.

Aneka-rūpa: Many forms.

- 5. Exercise:
 - Cause is called: satyam (independent reality).
 - Effect is called: mithyā (dependent-reality on independently existing principle).
 - Pick one object, and resolve it's existence all the way down to final satyam (consciousness), using satya/mithyā logic.
