 - 2. Iśvara is all-pervading. Sarvagatatvam (being everywhere, omnipresence).
 - 3. Īśvara is support of all, the **substratum of the mithyā universe**. Jagat adhiṣṭhāna (Abode of world).
 - 4. I am **creator**, **sustainer**, **swallower** of mithyā universe.
 - 5. I am unsullied. Asangatvam.
 - 6. I am akartā/abhoktā. Free of all karma and karma-phalam.
